MODERN SLAVERY STATEMENT

Ardo UK Ltd will not tolerate acts of modern day slavery either within our own business or within our supply chain. The Company acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Day Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within the organisation and with suppliers of goods and services to the Company.

We are part of ARDO N.V. a Belgian owned family business that is one of the largest frozen fruit, vegetable, herbs and carbohydrate (potato, rice and pasta) producers in the world. Through our aim to be a sustainable company we have a high level of commitment to the people who directly and indirectly work or supply products and services to us.

Within the UK we take all reasonable steps to ensure that people who work for us are not subject to slavery or human trafficking. We are committed to the Stronger Together campaign.

Other Ardo companies within Europe who supply the UK will comply with their own national legal requirements regarding the prevention of slavery and human trafficking in their supply chains.

If required to source raw material from a non-Ardo company we will prioritise the use of SEDEX registered suppliers.

The company will not knowingly support or deal with any business that is involved in slavery or human trafficking.

The Company Directors and Senior Management take the responsibility for implementing this policy statement and will ensure that adequate resources are made available to ensure human trafficking is not taking place within the company or our supply chain.
